Unfortunately not all of our news this week is positive. As you will remember our gate was damaged on the first morning school resumed after our summer holiday. It has now been fixed as the motor had to be replaced. This damage occurred through a parent/carer pushing and forcing the gate open whilst it was moving. This effectively burnt out the motor and ended up costing school £559.00 to repair. Please, can everyone wait for the gate to open without pushing or forcing it as we now have £559 less to spend on the children's education. In addition, we had an incident last week where a small boy was hit by a child pedalling their bicycle on the yard. NO bikes, scooters, go-carts or wheeled vehicles are permitted to be pedalled on the yards. Adults and children need to ensure bikes etc are pushed when entering and crossing the yard.
