Message from the Governing Body regarding pursuit of Penalty Notices for unauthorised holiday absences IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Our school Attendance Policy states 'Excellent attendance promotes excellent learning. Regular school attendance is essential if children are to achieve their full potential. In the year 2016-2017 our school's attendance % fell below the national average for the first time. After analysing the data it has become apparent that school is not affected by higher than average illness (we are below average for this) but holiday taken in term time.

The relevant governing body committee discussed this issue at great length and reluctantly agreed to instruct Northumberland County Council to issue Penalty Notices to all parents/carers of pupils who take unauthorised holiday during term-time and meet the relevant criteria.
