On Monday, the children in reception to Year 4 will take part in an assembly called 'Speak Out, Stay Safe'. This assembly will teach children how to recognise harm in an age-appropriate way and they will learn about the different types of harm and how that might make them feel. The assembly (which is introduced by Ant and Dec) will also teach them about how to get help if they are being harmed. Nursery children will be learning the 'Pants' song in their classroom.

School Meals update

As you will know from the update this week, we have managed to secure a hot meal provision from 6th June 2024. We are very happy with this, although it is coming at a cost to the school which will impact on our budget position.

Councillor Les Bowman attended a meeting in school this week, where he spoke of his passion for this issue and advised that he was taking the matter further within Northumberland NCC and the Labour Party. He advised that he would obtain the additional funding from NCC to ensure that school was not financially adversely affected this year and will fight to secure a long-term solution for us going forward. Councillor Bowman spoke of his desire for us to have our own kitchen and intends to take this matter up with Northumberland County Council leaders. We will update you if and when any further information is available.

Year 4 Transition week arrangements

We have received the final transition week arrangements for Year 4 as follows: July 8th and 9th, children will be taught here at Holywell as normal. 10th,11th and 12th July the children will be taught from Whytrig Middle School – further details will be circulated regarding pick-up and drop-off arrangements nearer the time.

Governor news:

School Improvement Partner Damian Burke visited school on 20th March accompanied by Angela Hall Chair of Governors. The purpose of their visit was to talk with the Curriculum Teams within school and look at their individual subjects and knowledge.
