

PSHE

Relationships

The children will create their own class rules and think about what makes a successful learner. They will then explore the qualities of a good friend and how their choices affect others. They will learn about different types of relationships and families as well as how to stay safe online.

History

The Stone Age to Iron Age:

The children will learn about how we can find out about the past as well as identifying the key features of the Stone Age to Iron Age such as:

- Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic periods
- Settlements
- Farming/tools
- Animals

DT

The children will explore what makes a balanced meal and seasonal foods. They will then research, design and make a seasonal meal for a firefighter.

Music

Throughout the year, the children will have the exciting opportunity to learn to play the violin through fun games and activities.

Literacy

Narrative: The children will explore our class 'mystery book' linked to the Stone Age and write character and setting descriptions.

Poetry: The children will explore a range of poems focussing on rhythm and how word choice can have an effect on how poems are performed. They will then write and perform their poem.

Science

Animals including Humans

The children will learn that animals (including humans) need the right types and amount of nutrition and that they get this from what they eat. They will learn that humans and some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

PE

NUFC

The children have the exciting opportunity to work with NUFC to learn skills linked to attacking and fielding.

Dance

Year 3 will create their own Stonehenge inspired dance with our own PE guru Mr Jobson!

This term, the children will learn:
