- > seek opportunities in the local and wider community to strengthen the school's position in terms of collaborative partnerships.

You would be expected to attend one committee meeting and one full governing body meeting per term and make specific visits to school where appropriate.

Many employers appreciate the skills that being a school governor can develop so they may even allow you paid leave to visit school as part of your governance duties.
