

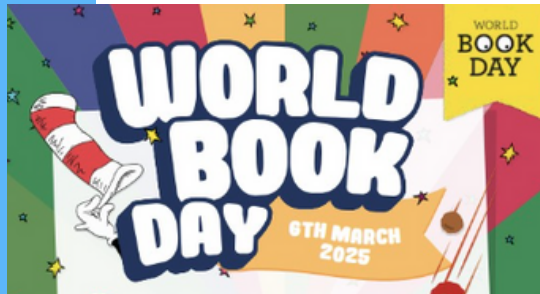

Following the half-term break, PE days will be changed to the following days and your child should come to school wearing suitable kit on these days:

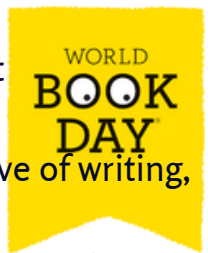
- Nursery and Reception - Tuesday & Wednesday

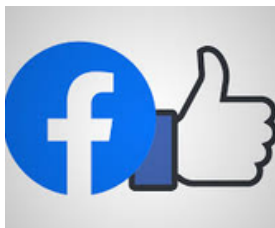
**READING AWARDS AND
